REGULAR BOARD MEETING

June 23, 2020

The Board of Commissioners of the South Walton County Mosquito Control District held its Regular Board Meeting at the District Office at 774 North Highway 393, Santa Rosa Beach, Florida on June 23, 2020 @ 9:31 am.

Madam Chairman Faulk called the meeting to order and opened with a prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

The Commissioners attending the meeting were Kristine Faulk, Tim Norris and John Magee.

The Minutes for May 19, 2020 Regular Board Meeting were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the minutes for May 19, 2020 by Commissioner Magee. Commissioner Norris seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Administration

We continue to comply with the CDC guidelines for COVID-19. The District administration building remains closed to the public.

The monthly financial reports and expenditures for May 2020 were reviewed and a move to approve was made by Commissioner Magee. Commissioner Norris seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Public Relations Report:

- Our YouTube channel has 6 subscribers. We are currently working on a new video, *A day in the Life at SWCMCD*".
- In the last 28 days, Facebook was visited 183 times, with 16 new page likes. Total people that like our page is 567 up 39 since May 19, 2020.
- Instagram has 162 followers since the creation in November 2019.
- National Mosquito Awareness Week June 21-27, 2020. We have a booth with educational and promotional items scheduled at the TDC, Culver's and Seaside. Rich Clark will be on the electric bicycle handing out material at Topsail Hill Preserve State Park.
- Continued planning for the virtual Panhandle Mosquito Control Workshop on September 22, 2020.
- Participation in the Grayton Beach July 4th parade.
- Creating a newsletter for HOA's

Building update:

Service Order 4 contains the proposal to build the Headquarters building. This Service Order is contingent on approval of current legislative changes on July 1, 2020 to the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act. Commissioner Norris made a motion to approve Service Order 4 to approve the Headquarters building at \$4,000,000 with the signed legislation for the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act. Commissioner Norris seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Service Order 5 contains the submittal of District ERP and Corps NW Permit applications and other permits necessary to process applications.

The On-site sealed bid auction for the approved vehicles and equipment will be rescheduled for August or September 2020 due to COVID-19.

In November 2017 the District partnered with Walton County to auction vehicles. The proceeds from the auction continue to be outstanding. Several attempts have been made to collect these funds. A motion was made by Commissioner Norris to invoice the county for the total amount of funds paid totaling \$15,865.00 paid by Midway Machinery to Walton County Comptroller on 11/28/2017. Commissioner Magee seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Legal

Manson Bolves Donaldson Varn, PA presented invoice# 8840 for May 2020 in the amount of \$3,410.46. A motion was made by Commissioner Magee to approve Invoice#8840 from Manson Bolves Donaldson Varn, PA for legal services for May 2020 in the amount of \$3,410.46. Commissioner Norris seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Operations

Mr. Yawn presented the Operations activity report for May 2020. The Sentinel Chickens have returned to the field. Currently working to replace all the old mosquito traps with solar traps.

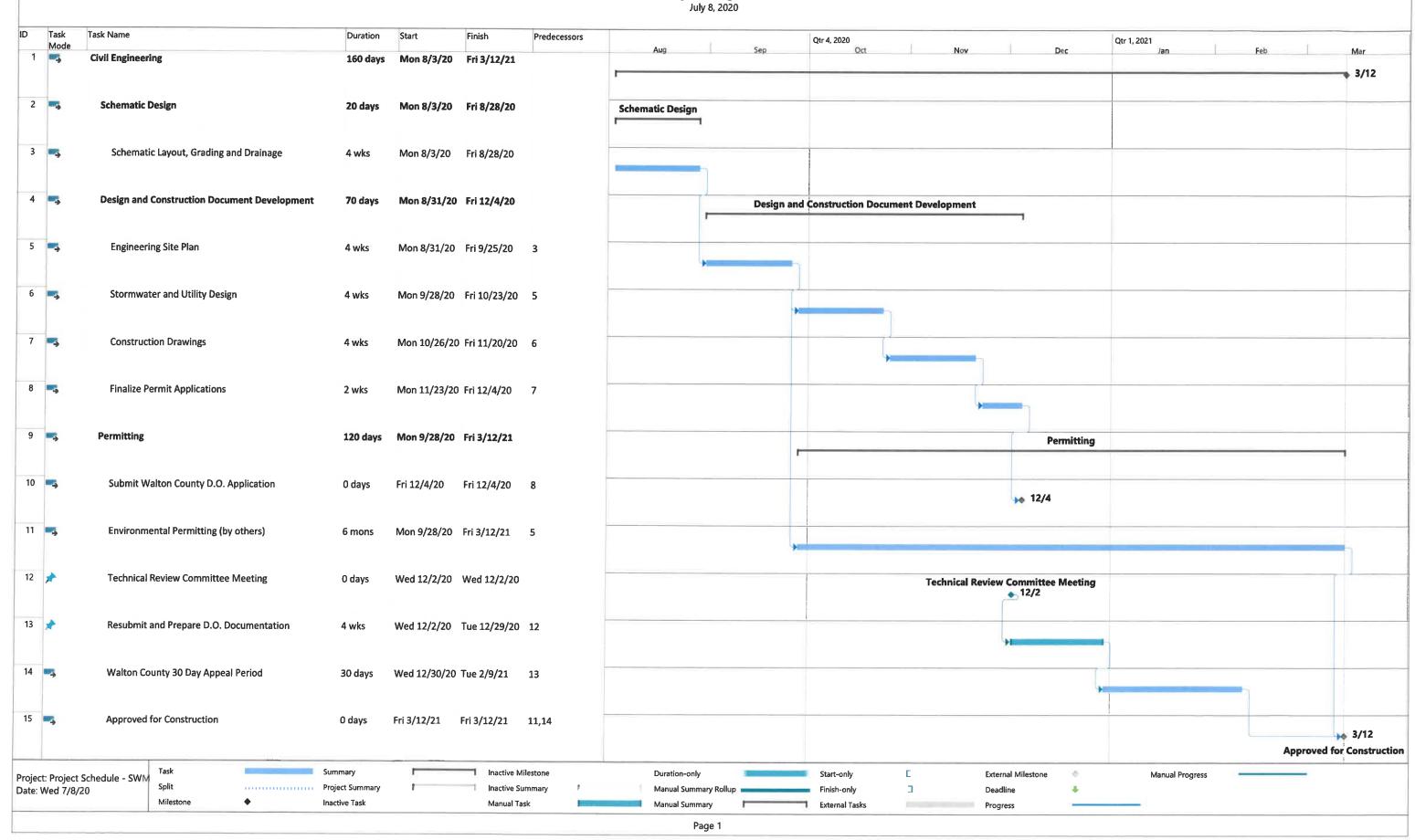
